The eYe program is structured, yet flexible. While the eYe program provides a logical process and supporting tools, members are in charge of their own plan for development. Teamwork is also an integral part of the eYe program as fellow club members serve as personal coaches to eYe participants.

Leadership Excellence Educational Development

Develop yourself as a leader with the Leadership Excellence Educational Development (LEED) program.

To achieve its unique role as an advanced club, Masters encourages its members to aim for leadership excellence by completing a formal program of leadership development. The LEED program (under development) is founded upon self-assessment and input from a personally selected advisory committee. The focus of LEED is the achievement of personal goals.

The performance arena for eYe will generally be Toastmasters club meetings; however, the performance arena for LEED will generally be outside Toastmasters club meetings, introducing challenging and dynamic

elements into your leadership adventure.

Masters is a community of dedicated Toastmasters with diverse communication and leadership strengths, experiences, and styles. Just as we turn to one another for coaching in communication skills, we rely on the experience of our members as leadership mentors. Even our most experienced members rely on other members to serve as their Leadership Coaches.
